# Getting Started with Classroom 360

#### Overview

Classroom 360 is the next generation of SIS K-12 for teachers. It includes gradebook, report card grades, attendance, and other tools regularly used by teachers in a touch-enabled browser app.

In Classroom 360, year-long courses use a single gradebook. They no longer need be divided into separate gradebooks for each semester.


The SIS K-12 documentation page contains documentation for Classroom 360 functions as well as short instructional videos.

### **User Permissions**

Permissions for Classroom 360 are the same for teachers as they were in classic.

## Accessing Classroom 360


On the Staff tab, enter your Username and password then select 360 Login.





### Home Page

When the Home page displays, in the top bar, the school and year into which you are logged in are shown.




The **My Classes** panel displays all the courses assigned to the user and the **Show Classes For** field displays the day and date of the classes listed. The icons in this panel access features as described below. Actions applicable to a course are listed via the **Actions** icon : for each course.

### Settings

Each user can configure elements on the page the page using the orange Settings (top left) option.




Drag and drop the desired items then select **Save**.






#### Menu

Click the **Menu** icon top left of the blue bar to display the areas to which you have access. Those with more extensive access/menus can use Search to highlight areas (select the **X** to return to the full menu).






#### **Preferences**

In the top bar, the **User/Preferences** icon shows initials of person logged in and provides access to user-specific functions. Preferences allow each user to personalize how 360 works (some screens also provide the **Preference** icon in the bottom bar).

Select a tab on the left to view and edit the options available. In the example below, to edit or re-order columns and buttons on the Home page, drag items from the Available columns to the Show columns (or the opposite to hide them).





### Top Tool Bar

Every page in Classroom 360 has a top tool bar and a bottom tool bar. The top bar remains static and allows quick navigation throughout the application:

- Menu –Quick access to any area in Classroom 360.
- Home -- Return to Classroom Summary/Home page.
- **School** Switch schools, if you have courses in multiple schools.
- **Year** Switch between school years.
- Class Active when viewing a single class, click to change to a different class.
- Student Search for a student and view their information from Student 360.
- Student Focus Active when viewing a single student, click to change to a different student.
- Pulse -- If licensed, access Pulse features.
- Reports -- Access the My Reports screen.
- Favorites Like the Favorites area in Classic SIS, you can navigate to screens you frequently visit. To edit this list, click on the Favorites icon and choose Edit Favorites.
- Links External links to other sites. If you used External Favorites in Classic SIS, those favorites are now Links.
- Print Page -- Print the currently displayed page.



- Help -- Access the SIS K-12 documentation page, view About SIS K-12, or access the training site
- User Menu (displays as your initials) Access to change your password, see your Meal Service, change Preferences, or log out of Classroom 360.

#### **Bottom Tool Bar**

The bottom bar contains context-sensitive actions that change depending on the screen displayed. Classroom Summary has:

- Legend -- To display what the icons in the My Classes panel mean.
- Filter -- Filter the classes displayed by various criteria and/or change the columns displayed.
- **Export** -- Export the content of the screen to a spreadsheet.
- Refresh -- Refresh the screen display.
- Mass Email -- Set up an email to selected rosters.
- Preferences -- Sometimes, as on this screen, you may see a Preferences icon. When you click **Preferences** on the bottom toolbar, you'll see same options as clicking the User icon Preferences or the left-side menu System Settings options.
